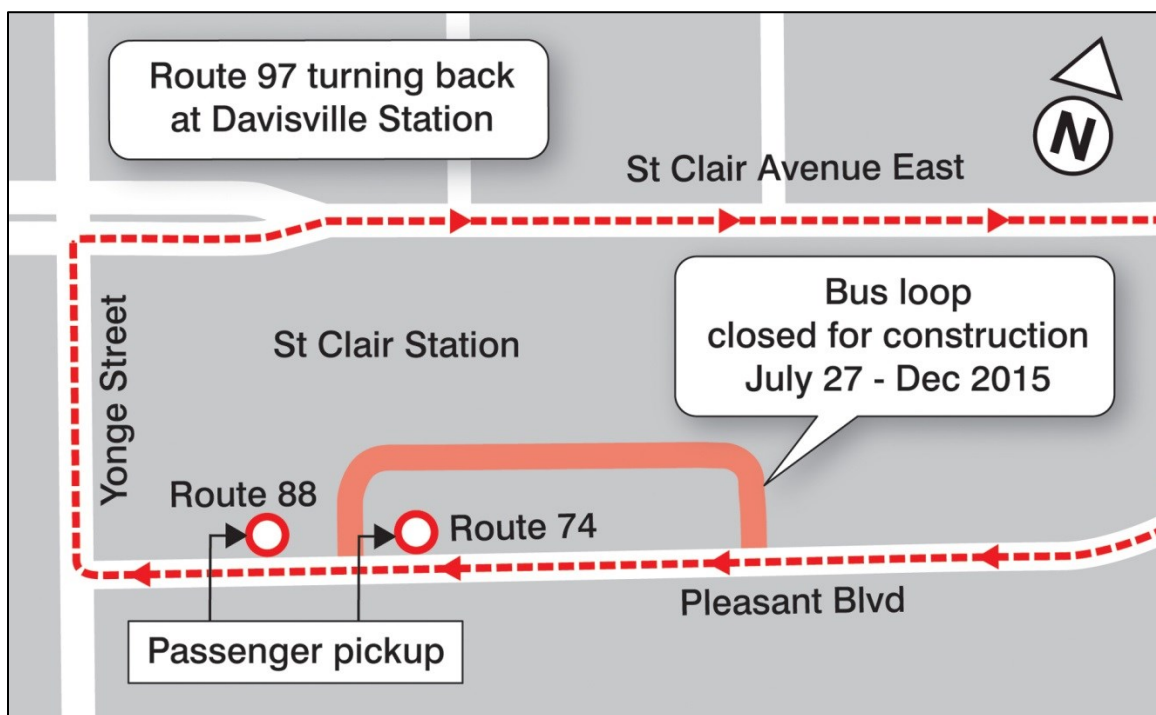

St Clair Station Bus Loop Closure for Rehabilitation and Pavement Restoration

Start Date: As early as July 27, 2015

Content/timelines accurate at time of printing

TTC will be rehabilitating the St Clair Station bus bay area on Pleasant Boulevard. We would like to provide you with an update regarding upcoming construction activities in your neighbourhood. We thank you for your patience as we work to improve transit in Toronto.



Description of work

Starting as early as July 27 through to December 2015, the bus roadway at St Clair Station will be closed for rehabilitation and pavement restoration. Crews will relocate a catch basin within the roadway of the bus bay area. TTC light poles will also be relocated onto TTC property; in the meantime, temporary lighting will be installed. Repaving of the bus loop will also be completed.

For safety reasons, pedestrians will be separated from construction with a chain link fence.

Transit service changes

All buses will be removed from the bus loop at St Clair Station during repaving and rebuilding of the bus roadway.

- **74 Mt Pleasant and 88 South Leaside**

During construction, buses will loop via south on Avoca Avenue, west on Pleasant Boulevard, north on Yonge Street, and east on St Clair Avenue. Buses will serve on-street stops on Pleasant Boulevard near the bus loop exit.

- **97 Yonge**

During construction, 97 Yonge buses will not serve St Clair Station and will turn back at Davisville Station.

- **312 St Clair (Night Bus)**

The Blue Night service will not be affected.

Customers paying with cash, tokens, tickets, and Presto will require a paper transfer to access the station.

Please note that once the project is completed, the 74 & 88 bus routes will return to their regular routing via Avoca Avenue & Pleasant Boulevard. Streetcars will continue to use the St Clair Avenue entrance.

- **Pleasant Boulevard:**

Street parking on some portion of Pleasant Boulevard will be limited during this time. The sidewalk and station entrance on Pleasant Boulevard will remain open.

Work hours

The majority of work will take place between 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. Some overnight and weekend work will be required during the course of this project.

Noise and Vibration

Noise and vibration associated with construction can be expected with this work. Efforts will be made to keep both as limited as possible.
